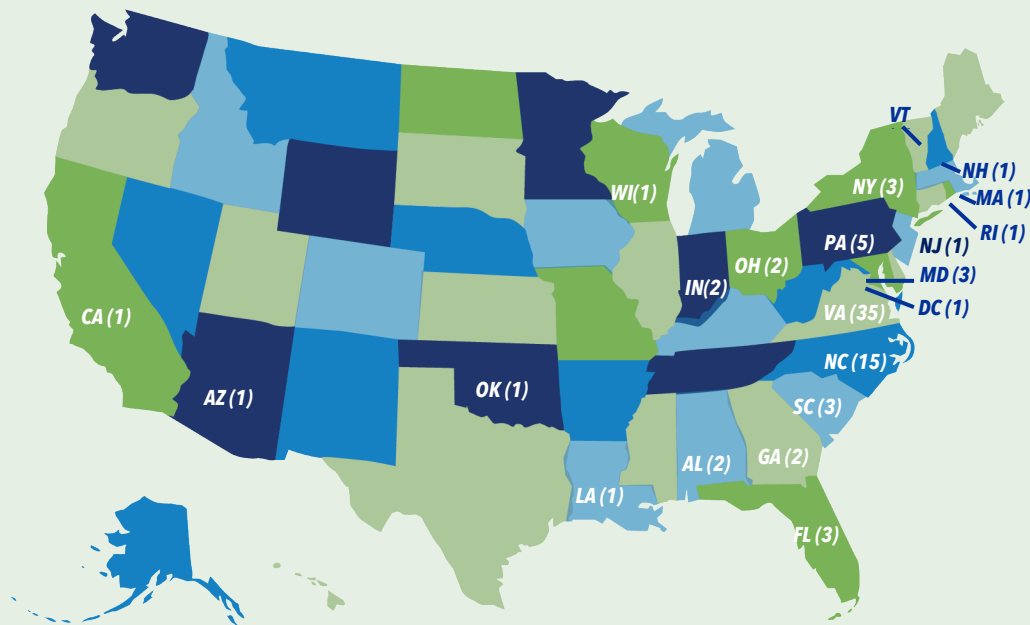

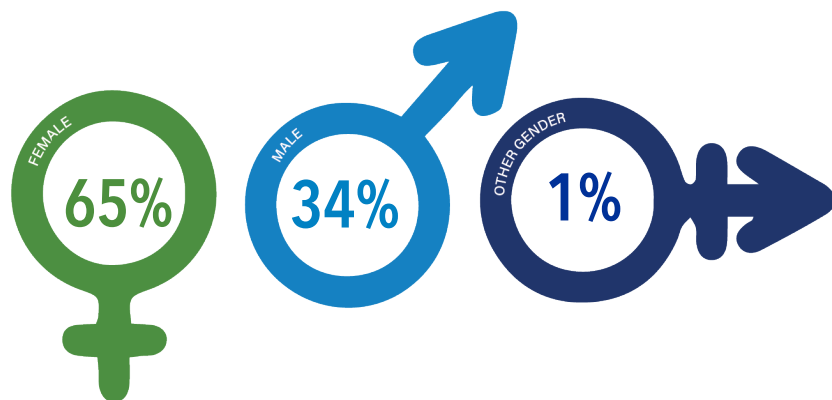

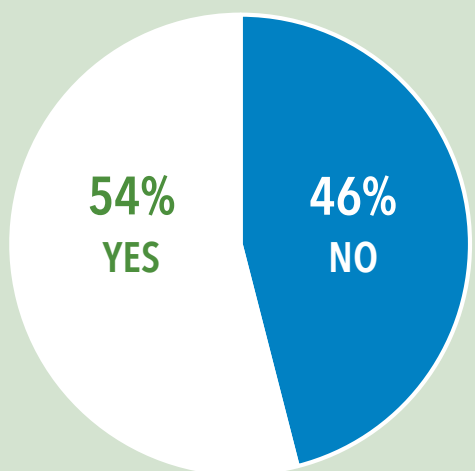

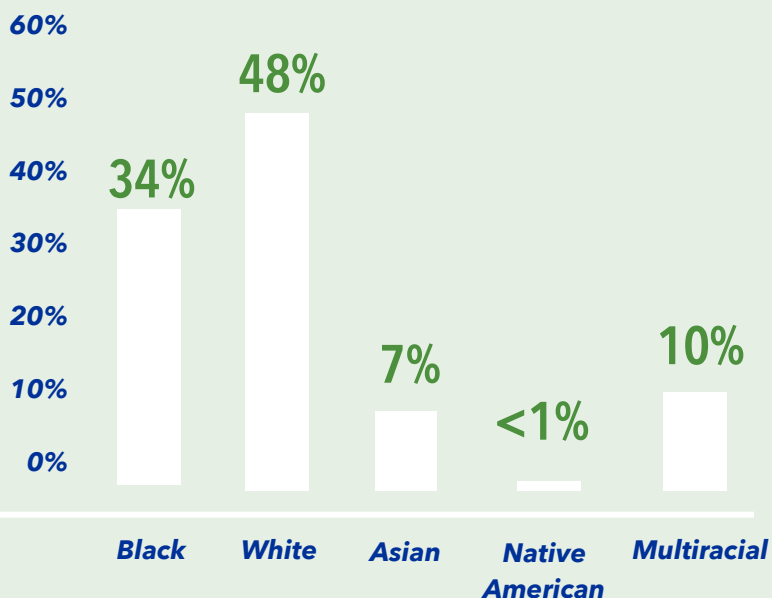


PELL GRANT ELIGIBLE UNDERGRADUATES
